Prayer for Those Taking Communion

Prayer of Belief

I thank you for paying my debt, bearing my punishment and offering forgiveness. Knowing you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as Savior and Lord. *Amen*.

Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way, the truth, and the life. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me, and open to me the reality of who you are.
